




School Background






Lesson Arrangement

 - 4C + 4D = 4C, 4D, 4CD






Liberal Studies Curriculum Framework

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Independent Enquiry Study

- In SS1, the basic knowledge of conducting research (e.g. how to collect and analysis data) will be integrated into the teaching and learning process.
- In SS2 and SS3, 2 lessons will be allocated to IES lessons. At that time, all six groups will have lessons together.
- Students will be divided into groups in accordance to their research area.
- Quota will be set for each research area and students will be supervised by the same teacher for both years.
- After handing in their projects in SS3, students can join the revision groups organized by teachers concerned.





- CUSP has provided guidance in the integration of the 3 humanities and preparation for NSS LS with regard to development of the curriculum framework, teaching strategies, level of difficulty, assessment criteria and methods
- CUSP has provided us with the opportunities to observe the teaching of Liberal Studies and samples of work
